SCHEDULING ORDER

In light of the status conference held telephonically and in open Court on December 12, 2011, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Defendants are limited to a total of seven additional depositions and the number of discovery requests discussed in the status conference held on December 12, 2011.
2. All discovery requests shall be served no later than December 16, 2011. All answers to discovery requests are due no later than December 23, 2011.
3. Trial is scheduled to begin on January 17, 2012 and end on January 26, 2012.
4. Parties shall meet and confer and be ready to advise the Court at the next telephone status conference regarding: 1) a proposed witness list for trial; 2) proposed length of testimony for each witness; and 3) the proposed order of witnesses to testify at trial.

5. The direct written testimony of witnesses that will be cross-examined in open court the week of January 17, 2012 shall be filed no later than January 10, 2012.
6. The direct written testimony of witnesses that will be cross-examined in open court the week of January 23, 2012 shall be filed no later than January 17, 2012.
7. The written testimony of witnesses that will not testify at trial shall be filed no later than January 26, 2012.
8. A telephone status conference is set for December 15, 2011 at 10:45 a.m. E.S.T.
